- This year's Robotics team advanced to regionals after placing third in the district competition.
- Freshman track and field standout Elizabeth Roca broke the school record for the 400-meter dash running a 57.87 during the Area Track Meet held on April 19 and 20 at D.W. Rutledge Stadium. And, junior Gavin Davis placed first in the boys varsity 400-meter dash setting his own personal record.
- Senior basketball standout Kobe Thompson accepted a scholarship with Lubbock Christian University and will continue his academic and athletic career starting in the
